OUR MISSION

Family Promise of Athens is a non-profit organization committed to providing housing supports to families with children who are facing or experiencing the crisis of homelessness.

PROGRAMS

PREVENTION

We assist families who are at risk of becoming homeless by providing rental and utility assistance, case management, landlord mediation, and referrals to community partners.

DIVERSION

We work to provide assistance to homeless families seeking shelter to divert them from shelter. This program includes case management and resources to help with upfront costs that prohibit families from moving directly into housing.

SHELTER

We provide food, childcare, transportation, case management, and other resources each family may need. We also provide a safe and caring environment for families to recover and to achieve sustainable independence.

STABILIZATION

We strive to help families reach sustainability so they will never be homeless again. Case management is provided up to two years after families have become stably housed.
