For convenience, we recommend that you bring a foursome to the tournament. If you are unable to do so, we will assign you to one.

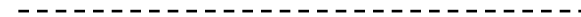
Because we are giving prizes for low net scores, it is necessary that you furnish us with your average score or in its place, your handicap index.
